
WITHIN THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH

TRAIL WIDTH AND CONTEXT SENSITIVE DESIGN

 THE CURRENT STANDARD 18 FOOT WIDE TRAIL (WITH UP TO 21 FEET OF DISTURBANCE) DOES NOT FIT IN PORTIONS OF SAMMAMISH

 THE CITY IS NOT ASKING THE COUNTY TO REDUCE THE WIDTH EVERYWHERE, BUT TO BE SENSITIVE TO OUR TREES AND RESIDENTS


• There are many great examples of **Successful** Trails that are 12 feet or less wide




• Hedges do not show up on County Plan sets


• MATURE SCREENING HEDGES ARE SIGNIFICANT TO RESIDENTS AND TRAIL USERS

SOUTH OF INGLEWOOD: 1100 BLOCK OF EAST LAKE SAMMAMISH PARKWAY NE










